**I need to stay home if...**

I have a fever



Temperature of 100.4 degrees or higher

I am vomiting



Have not vomited for at least 24 hours & able to eat food

I have diarrhea



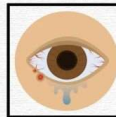
have not had diarrhea for the past 24 hours

I have a rash



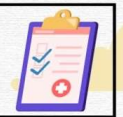
Unknown cause or cannot be covered or is distracting

I have eye drainage



Significant redness and/or pus draining from eye

I have been in the hospital



Hospital stay or emergency room visit



**I am ready to go back to school when I...**

Have not had a fever for 24 hours WITHOUT medicine (Tylenol/ibuprofen)

Have not vomited for at least 24 hours & able to eat food

have not had diarrhea for the past 24 hours

have been seen by a medical provider or rash has improved

No longer have drainage and/or have been seen by a medical provider

Have been cleared by my medical provider to return to school

• **Strep throat or another bacterial infection?** Stay home until the antibiotic has been given for at least 12-24 hours and your health care provider has given permission for your child to return to school.  
 • **Covid-19** - fever free for 24hrs and improved symptoms.
